Location: Ouachita Parish High School Gym—681 Highway 594, Monroe, La 71203 (Just north of I-20 on the east side of Monroe)

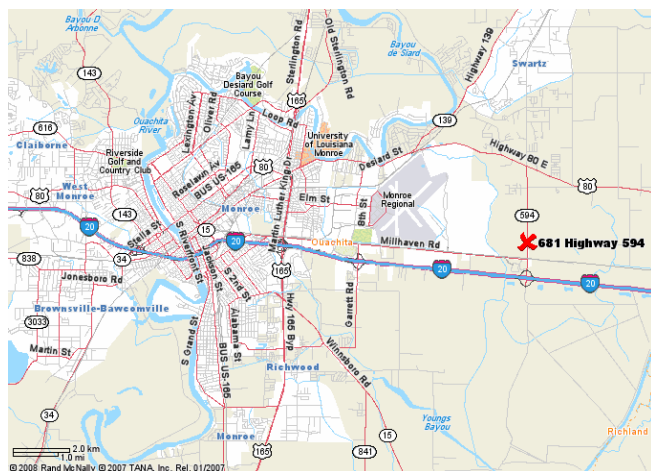
